Yes, It's Easy

My makeup skills are basic (my routine is the same no matter what), but I nailed this on the first try.

Pen > Brush

You need face paint and eye-liner for the look, but I used eye-liner whenever I could. Painting with a brush can be fussy; liner is more precise.

Customize It

Keep your face paint in mind. If your face is small, don't draw as many flourishes as Phan does. Make adjustments to suit your style.

Tough Scrub

Keep eye-makeup remover on hand for quick fixes. You'll also need it during clean-up. Getting the paint off is the toughest part.
